Beyond T cell inhibition: new functions for good ol' PD-L1

PD-L1 is best known to be the ligand of the inhibitory receptor PD-1, and therefore it has been strongly implicated in the suppression of T cell responses. In this seminar, I will describe our published and unpublished data on novel functions of PD-L1 beyond T cell inhibition, including how the PD-1/PD-L1 axis suppresses NK cell responses and how PD-L1 has an important role in regulating the efficacy of oncolytic virotherapy.



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
