***Short term and long term effects of
interferons and influenza on lung immunity***

Interferons are best known for their antiviral action, but they also have immunomodulatory and antiproliferative effects. The balance between these effects will determine whether interferons contribute to protection or severity in respiratory viral infections. We also investigate whether self-limiting infections such as influenza change lung immunity long-term, beyond the complete resolution of the primary infection.
